

ESTHER CROWN CRAFT

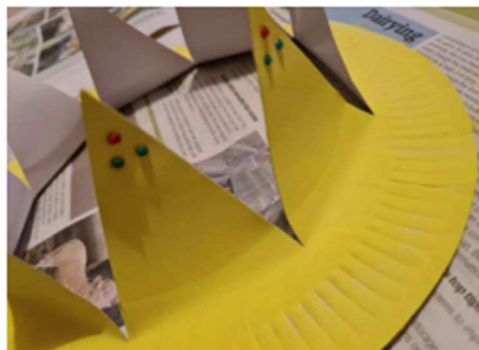
Esther Crown Craft

What you'll need:

- ★ Newspaper / old tablecloth (to protect table)
- ★ Paper plates
- ★ Paint / pens / pencils
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Decorations - gems, glitter, feathers, cotton wool, stickers etc.
- ★ Glue - PVA / sticks of glue
- ★ Hairdryer (optional)

How to make:

1. Firstly, prep - lay out newspaper/tablecloth to protect the tables.
2. To start, colour or paint your paper plates (base only) whatever colour you like, (if painting leave time for the plate to dry or use a hair dryer).
3. Take your paper plate and fold it in half (see step 3).
4. Starting in the middle of the plate cut a straight line about 8cm, or just before you meet the edge of the ruffle edge of the plate (see step 4).
5. Cut another 2 slits in the plate; this should be at a 45° angle from the first one (see Step 5).
6. Next, open the plate up and place flat with the inside down, adjust any of the slits if needed (see step 6).
7. Next, you'll need to cut two more slits where the edge was folded, (see step 7).
8. Next, bend the slit out towards yourself, until they stand up straight (see step 8).
9. Once they are all up straight it should look like a crown; so now it's time to decorate, use gems, stickers, feathers, cotton wool, glitter to finish it off.
